We're seeking people to join Greencrafts creative team

If you have an existing large or medium scale sculpture(s) or seating series you'd like to showcase to a festival of 210,000 people. or are able to bring and build an art installation, garden, seating or similiar onsite – then we'd love to hear from you, and please send us an application form with photos.

Places are filled by a mixture of "invitation" and "open-call" to new applicants.

Our deadline for INVITED creatives to register by completing and submitting this form is **February 27th**

+ our deadline for new people applying is **March 12th**

All applicants need to complete all parts of this form

Qualities sought

- Creatives need to be organized with good stamina and problem solving skills who're able to work in a self sufficient way, using their own initiative. We're keen to work with people who're friendly, reliable, positive minded and enthusiastic, with the ability to work well as part of a broader team with a "can-do" attitude.

Experience required

- We're seeking people who've experience of designing and making and/or locating their (or others) creative works in outdoor festival settings.

Tasks

- To bring your (or anthers) creative works to site and set-up, supervise, maintain and de-install / remove, leaving the site as found (eg: return soil to holes dug)

Requirements

- This is a very busy outdoor festival and pieces need to be robust to the weather and people.
- You come self-contained with all the tools, materials and equipment needed
- You work within our health & safety requirements (we're able to offer advice and support) and you take the risk of damage to any work (we have stewards on the field overnight)

What we can provide

- We can provide wooden poles (by prior arrangement - aprox 4m long, painted or stripped pine, can't be cut)

The Deal

- Each offer is individually arranged and includes Glastonbury Festival tickets, vehicle-pass(es), space to camp in Dragon Crew Field (adjacent to the Greencrafts field) and cash expenses to limited individuals.
- You'll need to arrive on Sunday 21st or Monday 22 June, and have work set-up ready for a health and safety check by Tuesday 23rd
- Those receiving expenses will be paid as self-employed and will need to provide us with an invoice, with your tax reference number, in advance
- It's understood that absolutely no alcohol or illegal drugs will be consumed on, or before install or take-down

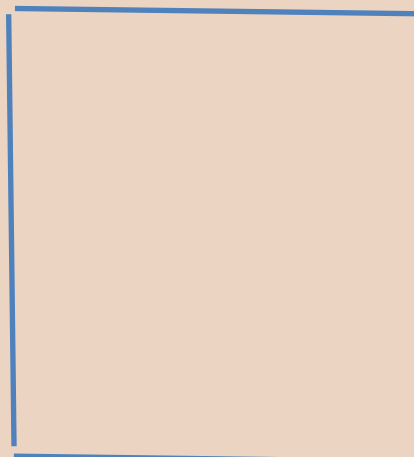

From outside of Ireland all letters need Europe postage & an airmail sticker. Ordinary post only - NOT couriered/signed for, as this may delay receipt. Allow 5 working days for post to arrive.

CAMPING PITCH

Crew will camp in The Greencrafts Field. As this area is within the Arena, it can be noisy. Back-of-house camping space is very limited and there is strictly no room for others to camp with you. Water is by shared stand-pipe and there's no electric available, and no 240V electrical equipment or generators are permitted. Camping may include caravans, trailer tents, tents and live-in camper vans. There may not be room for solar panels and windmills.

VEHICLE PASSES / PARKING

Bicycles are permitted on-site and motor-bikes, scooters, three-wheelers and quads are not permitted. Bookings are made on the understanding that all crew will:

- Not drive around the festival site. For access / exit, Keep to speed limits
- Bring everything you need when you arrive to site, as the event organisers do not want you driving in/out, causing extra on-site traffic/congestion

TRADING

Creative crew are not booked to or permitted to trade any items.

HEALTH & SAFETY

All crew are required to work within our health and Glastonbury Festival's H&S guidelines.

You'll be required to submit by e.mail a few forms to us including:

- A risk assessment and public liability insurance
- A fire retardant certificate (for any cloth, drapes etc included in the creative piece in public display)
- To sign the festival's contractors agreement

Please note, you're responsible for the H&S of your artwork / creative piece, in relation to the public and crew during the set up, event and take down. Please make contact with our H&S officers, when you arrive to site, to arrange a time when they can visit the sculpture when you'll be there. Greencrafts H&S crew are very experienced and able to offer you advice and support. We may request assistance in any H&S aspects relating to your work. Other council & festival H&S officers will also visit the field, please inform us of any contact with such staff.

We will forward further H&S notes and paperwork needed for you, if your application is successful

Further items Crew are Asked to Bring to Site

All crew are responsible for the H&S of your camp area and currently need to bring the following to the festival site:

- A basic first aid kit (there will be trained 1st aiders onsite). A fire blanket, water bucket or fire extinguisher
- All live-in vehicles and caravans need to be fitted with a carbon monoxide alarm and a smoke alarm
- All gas bottles stored outside need to be securely fixed in an upright position, by a wooden stake or similar
- Copies of all certificates as detailed in your application

Site for Artwork

We'll locate a site for your artwork, within the Greencrafts field, as part of our overall site plan. In some case you may be asked to hold-off setting up, until the crafts pitches around the site are in place, with an aim of both your work and crafts pitch being viewed at their best advantage. (ie: one not overshadowing the other) This may involve some patience. Your artwork will be 'out in the field' with you camped in a nearby(ish) 'behind the scenes' crew area.

Supervision

It's important that you undertake to keep an eye on the piece throughout the event and maintain, adjust, repair if needs be. Some site decorators ask craftspeople pitched nearby to their work, if they'd please keep an eye on it for them as the festival nor Greencrafts can be held responsible for any damage or loss.

Clear up and Leaving Site

All bookings are made on the understanding that everyone agrees to dismantle and clear their workspace and camp space totally, by Tuesday after the event.
