SITE CREW Application Information

We're seeking people to join GreenCrafts, and work with us as part of a small, site-crew team at ATN festival at Ireland's Curraghmore House in County Waterford; open to the public from **July 31st to August 2nd**. Places are filled by a mixture of "invitation" and "open-call" to new applicants. If you'd like to apply, please post a **hard copy** of this application form with supporting letter to arrive to:

Qualities sought

- Site crew need to be self motivated with good problem solving skills and stamina who can work on their own initiative. We're keen to work with people who're friendly, punctual, positive minded and enthusiastic, with the ability to work well as part of a team with a "can-do" attitude.

Experience required

- We're seeking people who've experience of festivals and festival work with carpentry, greenwood building, tree surgery and/or site laboring skills. If you can bring and work a chainsaw (with PPE and certificate plus insurance) it's an advantage.

Tasks include

- A variety of labour based work as part of a small, self-organising team, including: gathering / moving site materials (eg: timber), setting up wooden fencing, signage, seating, flag-poles, decorations, digging holes etc. For both build (advance set up) and/or break (take-down) times.
- Recognising potential hazards and fixing them (eg: signage falling down), gaining help (eg: first aid, security etc.) if needed.

The Deal

- We offer a festival ticket, vehicle-pass, parking space for a campervan or caravan, space to camp and some cash expenses.
- "Pre-event site-crew" is 3 days work starting on **Tuesday 28 July** until mid-day **Friday 31 July**, "Break/take-down crew" is **Monday 3rd July**. A vehicle is an advantage for this (please detail on form)
- You need to bring your own tools, including a sledge, light and lump hammer, a handsaw, spade, shovel, tape-measure, knife, screwdriver and sanding block. Also to bring your own personal protective equipment, a first aid kit, gloves, notebook and pen, hat, sun-cream, torch, waterproof clothing and sturdy boots, and agree to wear a high viz at all times when working.
- Further optional but desirable tools are an auger, wheelbarrow and petrol strimmer (with appropriate PPE, certificate / insurance). Please let us know if you are able to bring these – there may be additional small funds available for loan of same.
- We'll lead a team meeting on the morning of **Tue 28 July**. All crew must attend.
- Bursaries are available, paid as self-employed, via advance invoice with your tax reference details. They range between €50 to €300
- We request you assist us in any H&S aspects relating to the field if the need arises, and you provide us with a risk assessment
- It's understood that absolutely no alcohol or illegal drugs will be consumed on, or before shift / briefings so as to impede crew's judgement, and no headphones to be worn while on shift.
